Berthoud, CO—Summer is around the corner at 3rd Street and Mountain Avenue in historic downtown Berthoud when the fourth annual Berthoud Farmers’ Market is set to begin on Thursday, June 15, 3 to 7 pm. The open-air market happens every Thursday through October 19.
